## **CALL FOR WORKSHOP PROPOSALS**

The workshops will take place on **Monday, December 10, 2018**, the day preceding the 15th International Wildland Fire Safety Summit & 5th Human Dimensions of Wildland Fire Conference in Asheville, North Carolina.

The purpose of the workshops is to provide a forum for researchers and practitioners in wildland fire to discuss and exchange interests on a defined topic. We view these workshops as an opportunity for technology transfer: the process to ensure that scientific and technological developments are accessible to a wide range of users who can then further develop and apply them.

There will be a nominal registration fee for participants (\$10-\$30); this fee will cover the cost of the meeting rooms, refreshments and audio-visual equipment.

Proposals should contain the following information

- The title of the workshop
- The names, affiliations, email addresses and phone numbers of the workshop instructor(s)
- A short bio (*100 words*) of the workshop instructors, including a description of their qualifications relative to the topic area
- The proposed length of the workshop (we anticipate offering 2-hour, 4-hour, and 8-hour workshops; contact the conference organizers regarding other workshop lengths)
- A brief description of the workshop
- The maximum number of participants (if any). *Workshops with less than the minimum may be cancelled at the discretion of the conference organizers, TBD).*
- Any special facility needs (e.g., LCD Projector, computer lab, internet access for attendees, etc.)

The evaluation criteria include overall quality and the fit with respect to the Conference program.
