### International Smoke Symposium History

- 2013 – Maryland: The inaugural International Smoke Symposium set a high standard for combining in-person and virtual engagement, attracting global participation.
- 2016 – Long Beach, CA: Building on that success, the second symposium further demonstrated the power of virtual connectivity to unite international attendees.
- 2020 – Fully Virtual: In response to the pandemic, the third symposium transitioned swiftly to an entirely virtual format, thanks to strong sponsor and community support. It was a resounding success.
- In 2026 the symposium will be held at the new Leigh Perkins Conservation Education Center in Tallahassee, Florida and will bring together researchers from the atmospheric sciences, the ecological sciences, mathematicians, computer sciences, forecasters/climatologists, social scientists, health professionals, technology developers, smoke responders and others to discuss the complex issues of wildland fire smoke and identify knowledge and policy gaps and opportunities for innovation and development.

**More than three hundred participants from emergency services, state, federal, and local government, industry, NGOs, research and education are expected to attend in Tallahassee.**
